Fill out session description along the top. List all the driver names in the left column. Also put them along the top row of the Driver Totals section. r/m means racing or marshalling and ID means Car ID 1-6 for that driver for that race (fill these out from the fixture grids on web site before you start). G is the car's grid position taken from previous heat's result (returning drivers start at the back). As the session progresses fill out the results. Pos/Time is that person's result for the race (time is for rally or qualifying sessions). Pts is championship points awarded (10, 7, 4, 3, 2, 1, and 0 for a non-finish). After the session, transfer all the championship points down to the totals table and do a tot-up to find the winner for that session. Your entire event will consist of several sessions of different types of racing (endurance, Grand Prix, Rally etc.).
